Government notifies last date for submitting applications under scripbased schemes

The government has notified the last date for submitting online applications for scrip-based schemes under the Foreign Trade Policy 2015-20 as **31 December 2021.** Further, the revised late cut provisions for the applications submitted upto 31 December 2021 have also been notified as tabulated.

No applications shall be allowed to be submitted after 31 December 2021. Applications submitted after the last date would become time-barred and late-cut provisions shall also not be available.

In addition, the government has notified that the validity period of aforesaid scrips, to be issued on or after 16 September 2021, shall be 12 months from the date of issue.
